What is the Rev. David Walsh Award? This award was established to honor individuals, organizations or companies that have contributed significant dedication, support and assistance to Deaf Catholics. It is NCOD's way of saying "thank you" not only for a job well done but for his/her leadership role and impact among Deaf Catholics.

Who can make nominations?

What needs to be done?

- ◆ Pray and think of someone who has dedicated at least 10 years in Deaf Pastoral Ministry. You may also consider an organization, church or company who has contributed in a special way to Catholic Deaf and their ministry.
- ◆ Type or clearly write the following information on your nominee. (Submitting names alone will not qualify; nominees submitted in previous years do not stay on the ballot, their names and information must be resubmitted.)
 1. Provide the name, address, telephone numbers and e-mail address of the person/organization making the nomination.
 2. Provide the name of the individual, organization or company to be considered for recognition. This should include address, contact numbers and their current position. Nominees do not need to be NCOD members.
 3. Please describe the distinctive contribution or significant positive impact to the Catholic Deaf Community that this person or entity have provided.
 4. What is the length of time this person has been involved in Deaf Ministry?
 5. Explain why you believe these contributions make this individual/organization/company worthy of recognition.
